


Bunka no Hi

WHAT: Bunka no Hi (literally Culture Day) is a holiday in Japan that celebrates Japanese culture. Bunka no Hi at the JCCCW, or Japanese Culture Day Festival, is a free cultural festival dedicated to celebrating, commemorating, and educating the public about Japanese and Japanese American Culture in the Seattle area. Children, families, and the general public are encouraged to attend this free event! Face masks must be worn while visiting. No appointment necessary.

MEDIA HIGHLIGHTS:

This year, we will be showcasing traditional crafts from all over Japan. The exhibit will display pottery, lacquerware, textiles, baskets, woodwork, metalware, bamboo and paper products and more. These objects are still made today using centuries-old techniques and are used in everyday life.

We are collecting items for the display from our community for this event until Sunday, October 31st. If you own traditional crafts as described above, please consider donating them to the J for the exhibit. After the exhibit, some of the items from Bunka no Hi may be available for sale at a fundraising event
